1. World Senior Chess Championships (50+, 65+ Individual) 2024
2. World Amateur Chess Championships 2024

BIDDING

- All bidders must fill in **BID FORM** **BID FORM ANNEX** completely. A bid for any FIDE Competitions onwards shall include the name of a **FIDE licensed International Organiser**.
- All bids should be submitted by the due date in sealed envelope or scanned documents to the FIDE Secretariat, postal address: Avenue de Rhodanie 54, 1007 Lausanne, Switzerland / Tel: + (41) 21 6010039 / Email: office@fide.com by **21st December 2023, 15:00 CET**.
- **BID FEE** - Any bidder must pay a bid fee until the bidding deadline. Bid fee is not refundable. If the bid fee is not paid, the bid will not be considered valid.
- **DEPOSIT FEE** - Within a month after being awarded FIDE Chess Championships, the organising member federation shall pay deposit fee according to General regulations of FIDE competitions. When the event has been successfully concluded (according to the bid and the regulations), the deposit fee shall be credited to the account of the organising federation or refunded.

Single FB accommodation in one of the official hotel and domestic transfer costs of the inspections must be paid by the organisers.
